About the BSAA Scholarship

Award

This scholarship is an award of \$1,500, to be used to purchase textbooks or other required academic materials. The award will be renewed for three additional years, as long as the recipient remains in school on a full-time basis.

Eligibility

- The applicant must be a college-bound graduating senior at Brighton High School in Rochester, NY, with a grade point average of at least 3.0.
- This is a need-based award.
- The applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student at a two- or four-year accredited educational institution.
- The applicant must agree to use the fund for textbooks and required academic materials only. Funds must be used within the school year and cannot be carried over to the following year.

Application Process

The student must complete the attached application and submit it to the Counseling Center by Friday, **March 4, 2011**. The applicant must include an essay of no more than 250 words, addressing the topic of *“What aspect of your Brighton High School experience (academic, extracurricular or community service) has had the most impact in shaping your future direction and why?”*

Selection Process

Five finalists will be selected from the applicants by a panel that includes two Brighton Schools Alumni Association (BSAA) Scholarship Committee members, two BHS faculty members, and one student. Finalists will be notified in April, and interviews will take place at the high school shortly thereafter. The final decision will be based on the student’s need, extracurricular and community activities, essay, and interview.
